

North Star Academy
Policy: Dual Enrollment Policy
Adopted: March 10, 2010

Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to articulate North Star Academy's (the "School") position on the dual enrollment of home schooled students in the School.

Policy

Pursuant to Utah Code Ann. § 53A-11-102.5, students may be dually enrolled in both the School and in home school under the conditions set forth herein.

A parent seeking to dually enroll a student must certify that the student will receive instruction (a) in the subjects the State Board of Education requires to be taught in public schools and (b) for the same length of time as minors are required to receive instruction in public schools, as provided by rules of the State Board of Education.

All students of the School must be enrolled in the School for at least the percentage of each school day required by the State of Utah for North Star Academy to receive full funding. Therefore, no student of the School will be allowed to dually enroll if they do not plan to attend at least this portion of each school day.

Requests for dual enrollment should be provided to the School's Principal using the Application for Home School Dual Enrollment.

Students who are dually enrolled in the School and in home school will only take the state Criterion Referenced Tests ("CRTs") and other assessments for the subjects for which they receive instruction at the School.
